'Wisley Visit'

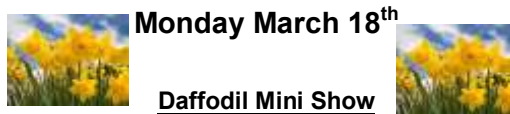
July 15th
